# Exam Times

Morning Exams will start at 8.50am

- Arrive to queue up at Sports Hall / Exams Office **by 8.40am**

Afternoon Exams start at 1.15pm

- Arrive to queue up at Sports Hall / Exams Office **by 1.05pm**

Lunch will start and finish at the normal times.

- Ideally bring your own lunch – be organised
- Yr 11s with an exam will have priority in the canteen queue

# Sports Hall Arrangements

- Seating Plans
  - Will be displayed on the windows next to PE
  - Two days displayed in advance - make sure you check the correct plan
  
- Lining Up
  - Line up in rows A to Q.
  - **Morning: top tennis courts**
  - **Afternoon: PE dance studio**
  - Silence when staff are talking to you
  
- Bags & Coats
  - Keep in lockers / Share a bag / Bring a small bag
  - Leave in the 'PE Corridor', in the correct area

# Exceptions

## Friday 5th am and pm

Exams will be held in M18 (dance studio behind the canteen); leave your belongings in M17 and line up in bus bays.

## French Listening and Reading (Tuesday 9th am)

Higher students (with no ET or Small Group concession) go to Sports Hall.

All other students in that session (including PE clash & Turkish) go to Exams Office.

# Exceptions

## **German Listening and Reading (Wednesday 17th am)**

- Higher students (with no ET or Small Group concession) go to Sports Hall.
- All other students in that session (including Product Design/RM & Latin clash) go to Exams Office.

## **Music and Languages writing (Wednesday 17th pm)**

- All students go to Exams office

## **Computer Science Paper 2 / Latin (Friday 19th am)**

- All students go to the Exams Office

# Students with Concessions

(Students with only Extra Time, Prompt or Rest Breaks are in the sports hall)

- Please gather between the 6<sup>th</sup> form entrance and the B block, by the metal gates
- Bring your bag with you
- You will be asked to leave your phones, watches, ear buds, Airpods, earphones and all smart devices at the Exams Office
- You will be sent to your exam room, where an invigilator(s) will be waiting
- Please tell your invigilator immediately if you do not have a concession you expected to have.

# Preparation

- Bring the **correct equipment** with you - this must be in a clear pencil case or bag (there is a limited amount of equipment available to borrow)
- Bring water in a **clear** bottle with the label removed
- Items you must leave in your bag / locker:  
phone, watch, Airpods, earphones, all smart devices

# Exam Rules

- Once you are in the exam room you are under **exam conditions**
- You must be **silent**, not turn around or communicate with anyone
- **Papers** must remain closed – *NEW: Formal report to the exam board if you open it*
- Invigilators will give you **instructions** before the exam starts
- You should have your own **equipment** - we will loan if absolutely necessary
- You must write using a **black pen**
- If you need **assistance** during the exam, raise your hand and wait for an invigilator to come to you
- **Toilet breaks** will only be permitted in exceptional circumstances – you need to consider how to manage this yourself
- You must stay for the **full duration** of the exam



# At the End of the Exam

- Invigilators will give you instructions when the exam finishes
- You will be dismissed row by row – silence until you have left the room
- Leave any borrowed equipment on your desk
- Return immediately to your timetabled lesson

# Timetabled Lessons

- When you aren't in exams you will attend your timetabled lessons
- Staff will complete a register when you arrive
- Teachers will make a decision to:
  - a) lead some teaching / revision for that subject
  - b) allow you to revise for other subjects in silence
- You will need to have revision materials with you for the whole fortnight
- Assume you will not have access to computers or phones
