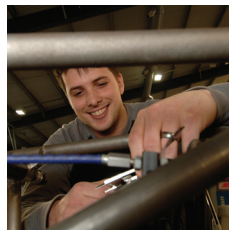

HELPING LOCAL STUDENTS REACH THEIR POTENTIAL AT UNIVERSITY

The Community Scholarship rewards students who have shown commitment to studies, overcome personal or social difficulties and/or have been an excellent role model within their school, college or community.

To be eligible, the student must be at a state maintained secondary school or college in Oxfordshire, or at one of our partner colleges*.

The student must also firmly accept a place on a full-time three or four year degree course at Oxford Brookes, or a foundation degree at one of our partner colleges.

Two scholarships will normally be available to each school and three to each college. Students can apply for the scholarship via our website. Nominations must have reached the university by **Wednesday 29 April**.
