Task 1

Each of these is an individual case study of someone who suffered from memory problems: Phineas Gage, HM, KF.

- Create a poster to summarise all three of these case studies. Use the ***CaseStudies.pdf*** file for information, but you can use any material you find on the internet as well (e.g. photos etc).

Your summary should cover the following for each case study:

- Some biographical information (who/when/where)
- What damage they suffered and how
- What the impact on their memory was

- Add 2 strengths and 2 weaknesses of using case studies to your poster.

TASK 2

- Work through the instructions to run and record your results from the Serial Position Experiment. The instructions are in ***SerialPositionExperiment.pdf***
- Write up the serial position study using p4 of the ***SerialPositionExperiment.pdf***
